The 2022 Classroom Teaching Research for All Students Conference (CTRAS)

We are pleased to announce the 2022 Classroom Teaching Research for All Students (CTRAS) Conference, to be held on June 15, 2022 online.

Background of CTRAS:

The Classroom Teaching for All Students Research Working Group was initiated in the U.S.- Sino Workshop in June 2008, which included 11 universities - five from China, and six from the U.S. Since then the CTRAS has been expanded to universities and school districts spanning more countries and regions from East to West. Each year, the CTRAS has a main research focus area and has an annual conference. The 2022 CTRAS is now set to be held in June 2022, online.

Conference Theme: Responding to new and old to support mathematics teaching for ALL students in the inclusive, equitable and meaningful classroom. As the covid-19 pandemic continues in various countries, math teachers are facing new challenges in student learning. Numerous instructional strategies have emerged to meet the diverse needs of students in math learning. Many research studies have been conducted to identify the effective classroom teaching practice in response to new challenges. The 2022 CTRAS will share and discuss current challenges and solutions in innovative teacher training programs, teaching strategies, and research practices that support ALL students' mathematics learning in inclusive, fair and meaningful ways. Contributions related to this theme and focused on epistemological, theoretical, methodological, social, cultural and linguistic perspectives are welcome.

Submissions and Important Deadlines:

Join the 2022 CTRAS virtually to share possible solutions for new and old challenges facing mathematics education, share innovative teaching/learning approaches supporting inclusion and equity in mathematics classroom teaching practice, and in the pre-service teachers' learning, and discuss the most contemporary research in mathematics education. Contribution can be a project report, a research report, or a research proposal.
